

Subject: Demand for inspection of shipments of Chinese goods jumps dramatically in 2007 (Nanos-University of Buffalo Tracking Study)

(Ottawa, Canada – December 28, 2007) – A longitudinal tracking study by Nanos Research and the University of Buffalo (SUNYS) shows there has been an increase in concerns among North Americans over the shipments of Chinese goods.

The Nanos/University of Buffalo North American Monitor shows that 48.4 percent Americans and 47.3 percent of Canadians believe that Chinese goods should be more thoroughly inspected than shipments arriving from other countries. In 2005 and 2006 Americans and Canadians were more likely to say that shipments from Mexico should be inspected. Now China has significantly surpassed Mexico as an inspection priority.

“2007 has registered a noticeable jump in Canadians and Americans that are concerned about Chinese goods”, said Nik Nanos, President of Nanos Research. “The number of North Americans who would want to inspect goods entering America has jumped 20 points in one year”, explained Nanos. “Research clearly demonstrates that there has been collateral damage to Chinese goods in the North American market.”

The tracking poll of 1,081 Canadians and 1,087 Americans, conducted September 4 to 7, 2007, online was based on representative samples of Canadians and Americans. The detailed statistical results from the survey are available at: www.nanosresearch.com.

The comprehensive longitudinal study also tracks:

- perceptions based on human rights, family values and business values of other countries in relation with Canada and the US;
- opinions on the thorough inspection of foreign visitors and shipments at customs; and
- views on whether Canada and the US should be working together in terms of national/border security, anti-terrorism measures and removal of the dependence on Middle East oil.

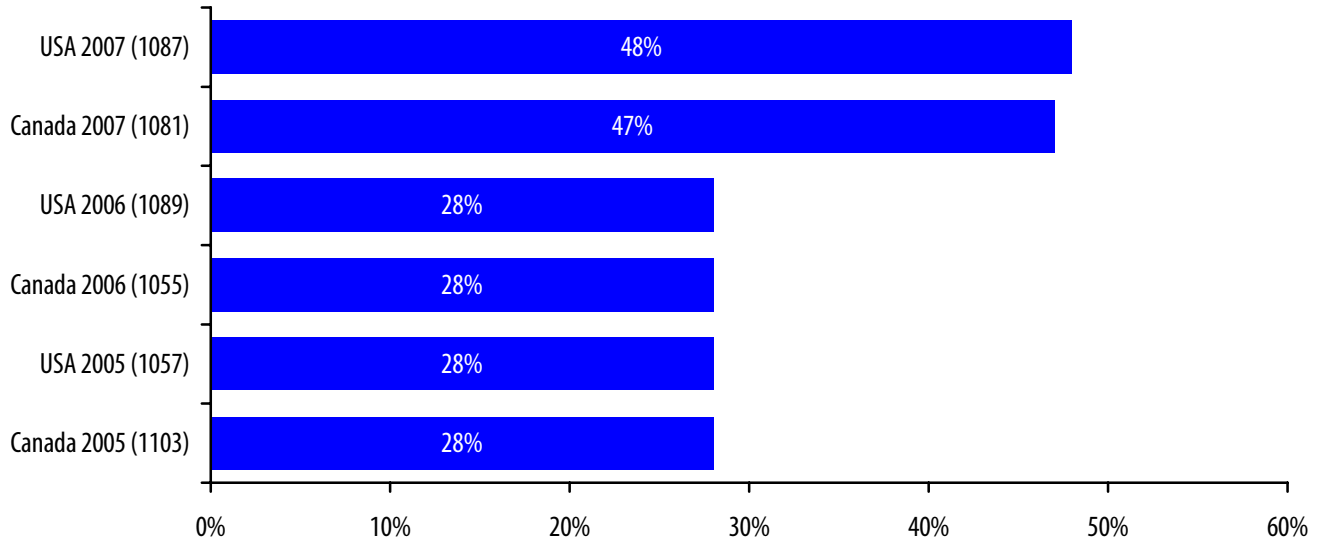
