Methodology

To follow is a review of the latest Nanos national random telephone survey of 1,001 Canadians 18 years of age and older. It was completed between April 4th and April 9th, 2008. The results are representative of the Canadian population and may be weighted based on data from Statistics Canada. A random telephone sample of 1,001 Canadians is accurate $\pm 3.1\%$, 19 times out of 20. A random sample of 829 committed voters would be accurate $\pm 3.4\%$, 19 times out of 20. The margin of accuracy will be wider for sub samples. Percentages may exceed 100 due to rounding.

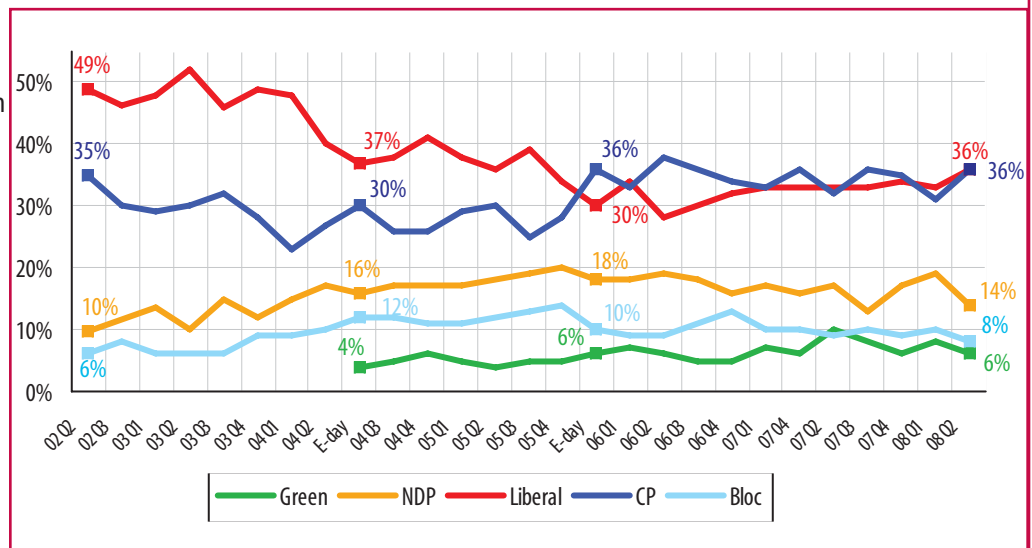

Methodology

To follow is a review of the latest Nanos national random telephone survey of Canadians 18 years of age and older. It was completed between April 4th and April 9th, 2008. The statistics of a random sample of 827 committed voters are accurate to within 3.4 percentage points, plus or minus, 19 times out of 20. The margin of accuracy will be wider for sub samples. Percentages may exceed 100 due to rounding.

The research was registered with the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association of which Nanos is a Gold Seal Corporate member.
