**Perceptions of Canadians on
Nuclear Power
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Methodology

To follow is a review of the latest Nanos national random telephone survey of 1,002 Canadians 18 years of age and older. It was completed between May 1st and May 6th, 2008. The results are representative of the Canadian population and may be weighted based on data from Statistics Canada. A random telephone survey of 1,002 Canadians is accurate $\pm 3.1\%$, 19 times out of 20. The margin of accuracy will be wider for sub samples. Percentages may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

More Canadians support than oppose more nuclear power

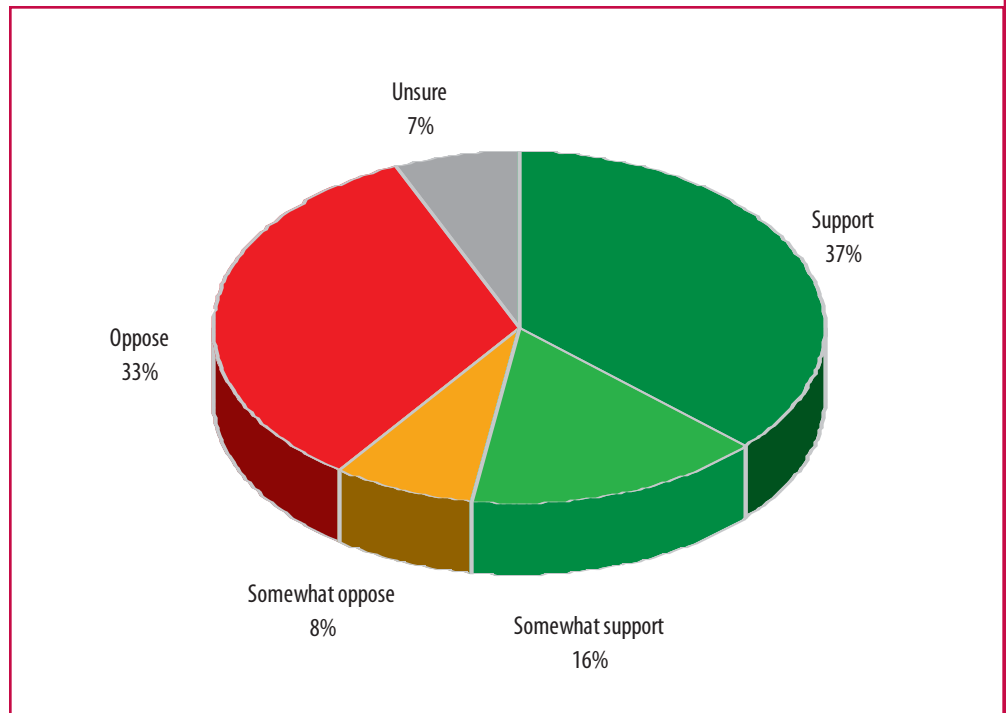
Methodology

Between May 1st and May 6th, 2008, Nanos Research conducted a random telephone survey of 1002 Canadians 18 years and older.

A random telephone survey of 1002 Canadians is accurate $\pm 3.1\%$, 19 times out of 20. Margins of accuracy are wider for subgroup samples. Readers should note that the data was weighted for gender and age to match the Canadian census results. Results should be considered representative of the Canadian population. Results may not add up to 100% due to rounding.

The research was registered with the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association of which Nanos is a Gold Seal Corporate Member.
