



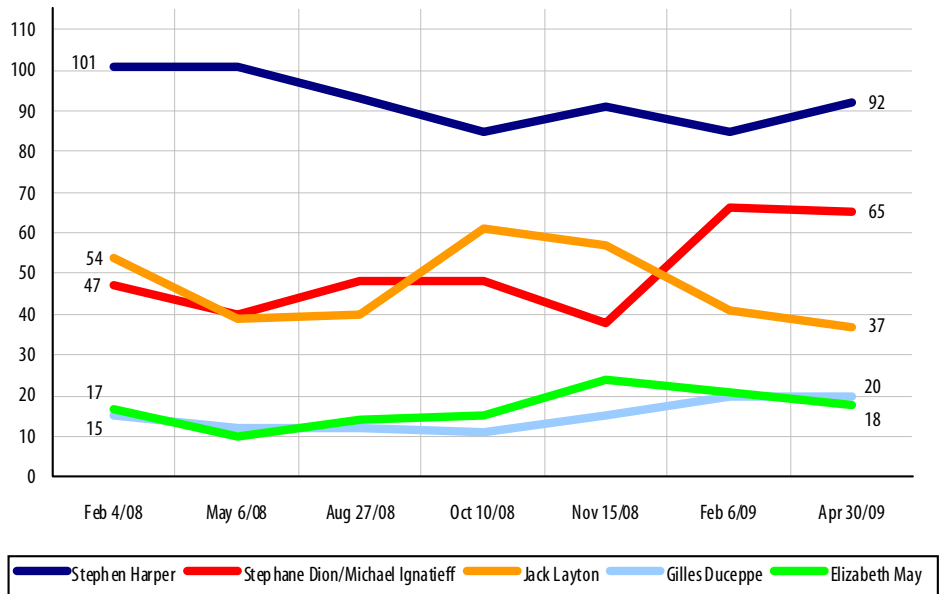
## Harper leads Ignatieff by 27 points

### METHODOLOGY

To follow is a review of the latest Nanos national random telephone survey of 1,001 Canadians 18 years of age and older. It was completed between April 25<sup>th</sup> and April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

The statistics of a random sample of 1,001 respondents is accurate to within 3.1%, for 881 committed voters, it is accurate to within 3.3%, plus or minus, 19 times out of 20.

The research was registered with the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association of which Nanos is a Gold Seal Corporate member.
