



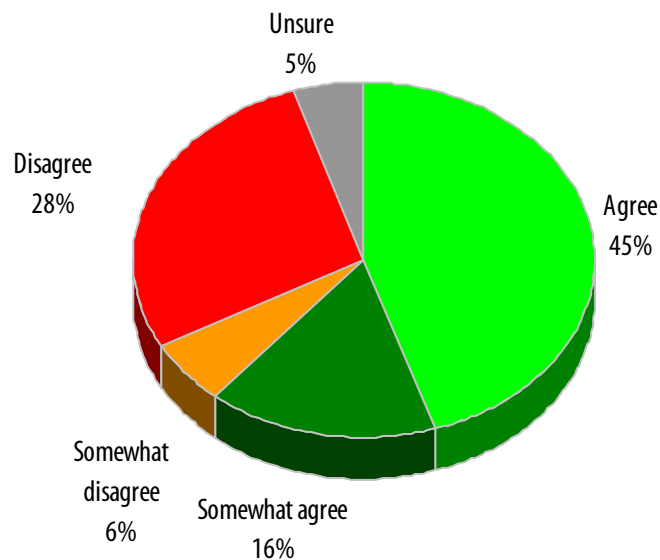
Should the federal government seek the transfer of Canadians on death row?

METHODOLOGY

Between March 13th and March 18th, 2009, Nanos Research conducted a random telephone survey of 1,002 Canadians 18 years and older. A random telephone survey of 1,002 Canadians is accurate plus or minus 3.1%, 19 times out of 20. Margins of accuracy are wider for subgroup samples. Readers should note that the data was weighted for gender and age to match the Canadian census results. Results should be considered representative of the Canadian population. Results may not add up to 100% due to rounding.

The research was registered with the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association of which Nanos is a Gold Seal Corporate Member.

QUESTION: Do you agree, somewhat agree, somewhat disagree or disagree that the Government of Canada has a duty to seek the transfer of Canadians who are facing the death penalty in another democratic country to a prison in Canada thereby avoiding the death penalty?
