



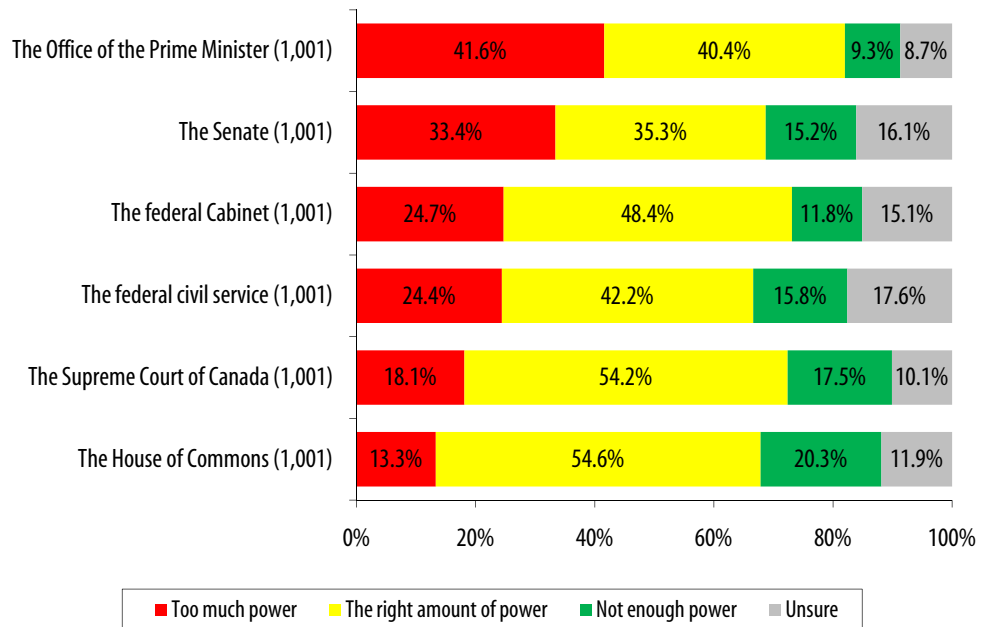
Canadians believe PMO has too much power, House of Commons not enough power

METHODOLOGY

Between February 5th and February 8th, 2010, Nanos Research conducted a random telephone survey of 1,001 Canadians 18 years of age and older. A random telephone survey of 1,001 Canadians is accurate plus or minus 3.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20. Margins of accuracy are wider for subgroup samples. Readers should note that the data was weighted for gender and age to match the Canadian census results. Results should be considered representative of the Canadian population. Results may not add up to 100% due to rounding.

The research was registered with the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association of which Nanos is a Gold Seal Corporate Member.

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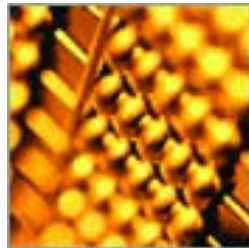
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
