Ontario Perceptions on Toll Fees
Poll March 30 - April 1, 2008
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Methodology

To follow is a review of a random telephone survey of 501 Ontarians 18 years of age and older. It was completed between March 30th and April 1st, 2008. The results are representative of the Ontario population and may be weighted based on data from Statistics Canada. A random telephone survey of 501 Ontarians is accurate $\pm 4.4\%$, 19 times out of 20. The margin of accuracy will be wider for sub samples. Percentages may exceed 100 due to rounding.

Ontarians oppose toll fees on major roads

Methodology

Between March 30th and April 1st, 2008, Nanos Research conducted a random telephone survey of 501 Ontarians 18 years and older.

A random telephone survey of 501 Ontarians is accurate $\pm 4.4\%$, 19 times out of 20. Margins of accuracy are wider for subgroup samples. Readers should note that the data was weighted for gender and age to match the Canadian census results for Ontario. Results should be considered representative of the Ontario population. Results may not add up to 100% due to rounding.

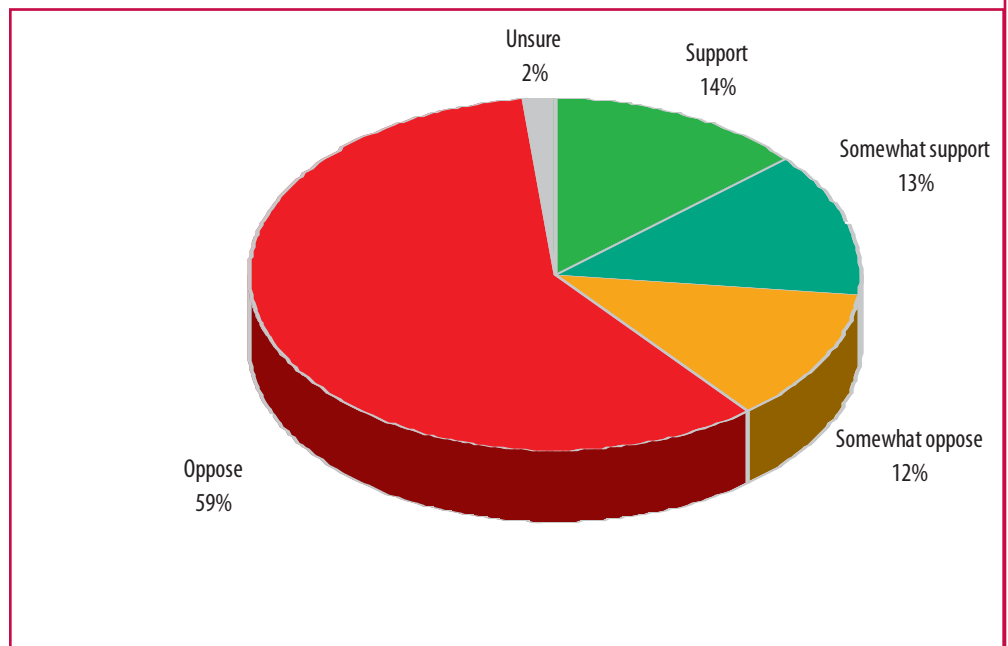
