

# [Poll: Majority of Canadians believe reservists should have job protected while on duty](#)

VANCOUVER (NEWS1130) - Nearly 90% of Canadians believe Canada has an obligation to ensure our veterans have a job after they've finished their service with the Canadian Forces, according to a new poll done by Nanos Research.

And not far behind, 88% of people believe reservists should have their jobs protected while they're on duty.

Allen Batchelar, CEO of Commissionaires BC says the military tries to prepare those who are leaving, but troops know they're returning one step behind the rest of the work place.

He says the reality is if you live and work in a community, and you need a job, you have a network that work in other places.

He adds, when you're in the military and restricted to large bases, you've lost those civilian contacts, and those people that could tell you where to go to help find a job.

Currently only some provincial policies protect some reservists's civilian jobs.
