

Dion has better numbers than Iggy, Bob and Dom

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Though it is still early days in the Liberal leadership race I got a kick out of this poll that was released by Angus Reid Strategies. According to this snapshot:

“Under Ignatieff, the Liberals reach 24 per cent among decided voters, 14 points behind the leading Conservatives (38%) and six points ahead of the New Democratic Party (NDP) (18%).

With Rae at the helm, the Grits are at 21 per cent, trailing the Tories (39%) by 18 points and two points ahead of the NDP (21%).

Under LeBlanc, the Liberals reach 17 per cent, 24 points behind the Conservatives (41%) and trailing the NDP by one point (18%).”

At the end of the 2008 federal election the Dion-led Liberal party stood at 26.2 per cent of the popular vote. A recent Nanos poll had the still-led Dion Liberals at 30 per cent.

Maybe Dion wasn't that bad after all.

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
