MONTREAL — Only a huge last-minute swing in voter support could give Stephen Harper a majority government, a new poll suggests. The survey, conducted by the Strategic Counsel for the Globe and Mail and CTV, puts Mr. Harper's Conservatives on a downward trajectory heading into the final weekend of the campaign.
